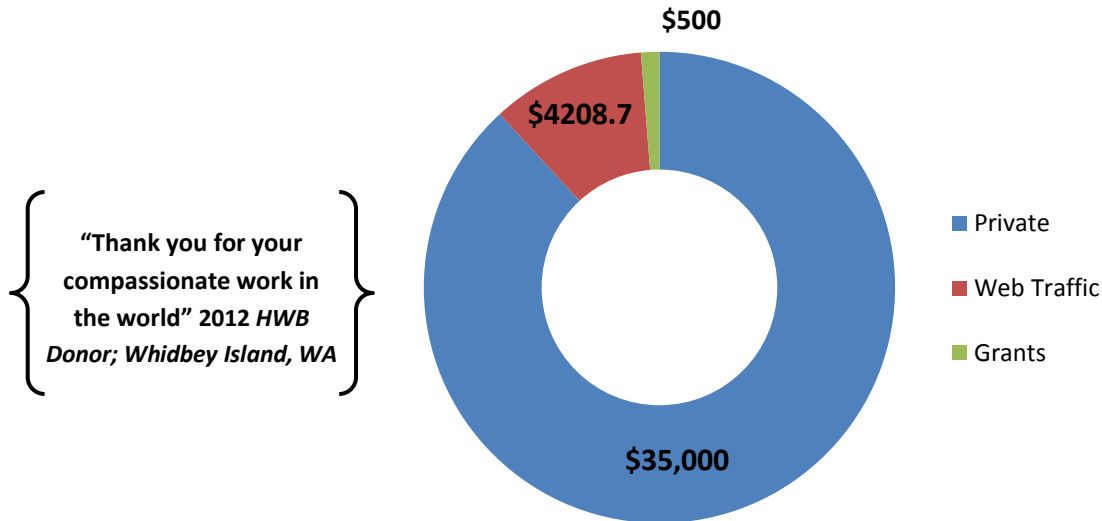

90% of HWB revenue comes from Private Donors

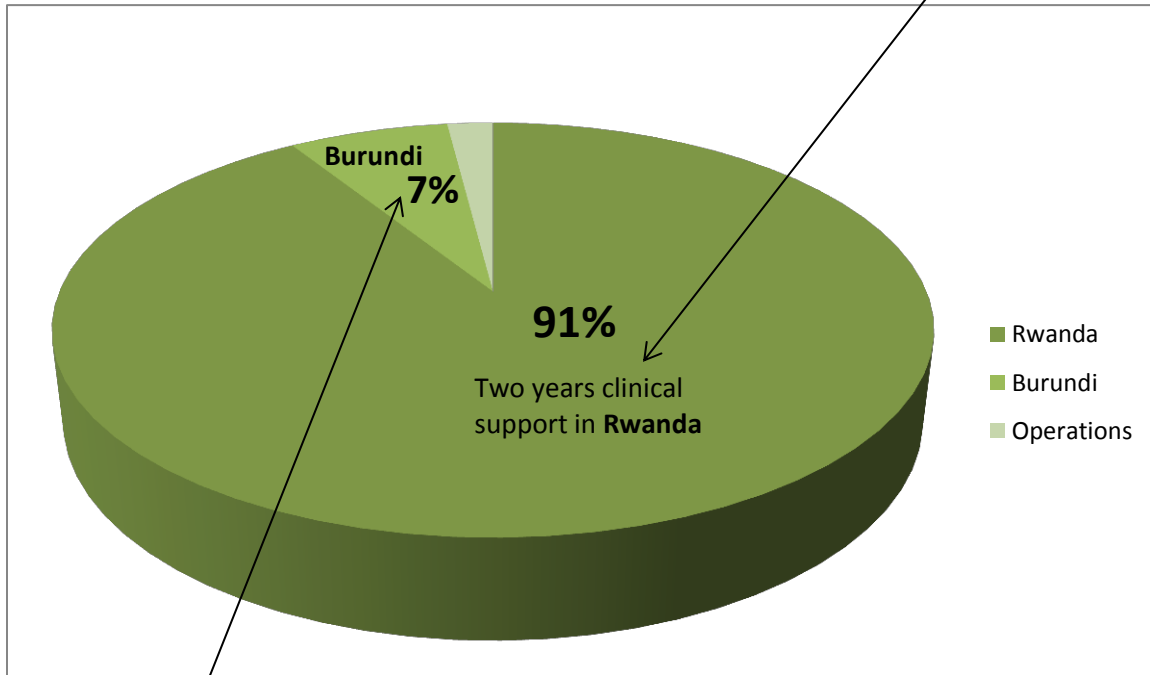
Revenue from Private Donors Helped Make the Following Possible for Rwanda in 2012
